Anacortes Brewery-Anacortes

1) Whistle Lake Weizen with Hatch Green Chilies (ABV 4.6% / IBU 18)

Our award-winning Hefeweizen has a cloudy golden color and a full, fruity traditional Bavarian character. aroma (made with the addition of fresh Hatch green chilies).

2) Herbert's Ale (ABV 7% / IBU 86)

This hoppy, Northwest-style Amber Ale is made with Skagit Valley malt and balanced with generous amounts of Centennial, Chinook, Cascade and Mandarina Bavaria hop varieties. Brewed to honor industry pioneer, Bert Grant, who opened the first craft brewery in the state of Washington.

3) Rainshadow CDA (ABV 6.1% / IBU 80)

Traditional northwest-style Cascadian Dark Ale. Dark, robust and aggressively hopped with Columbus, Simcoe & Cascade then "Triple Dry Hopped."

4) Valley Brown Ale with Hazelnut (ABV 4.5% / IBU 20)

The official beer of the Skagit Valley Tulip Festival, this easy drinking, medium-bodied seasonal is brown with an apricot hue and a light, roasty aroma. Grains grown in the same fields as Skagit Valley's tulips provide a blossoming malt flavor with roasted caramel notes. Perle, Cascade and Mt Hood yield a delicate hop character and a light, velvety finish (infused with hazelnut).

Black Raven Brewing-Redmond

1) sQuad on a Date Belgian Quad (ABV 10.6% / IBU 20)

This Belgian Quadrupel greets your nose with caramel and toast while brulee torched sugar and back molasses join medjool dates and peppercorns.

2) Pineapple Updraft Pale Ale (ABV 5.5% / IBU 45)

No matter your stance when it comes to pineapple on pizza, it surely works in this beer. Strata, Calypso, Azacca, and Citra hops bring it all together.

3) Westland Barreled Feather Weather Mocha Coffee Stout (ABV 7% / IBU 25)

An American coffee stout with Theo Chocolate cocoa nibs and cold pressed Moto Brew coffee meet a fresh cask from Westland Distillery.

Boundary Bay Brewery-Bellingham

1) DARK DARKNESS: A DARK PORTER (ABV 6.3% / IBU 25)

Dark Darkness unites a deep-chestnut color, aromas of cacao and light toffee with chocolatey and subtle roast flavors. This limited release porter celebrates the diversity of Bellingham's art scene. The porter's namesake is an offbeat web-series produced in Bellingham, Washington by Wilson Large, a former Boundary Bay employee.

2) INSIDE PASSAGE ALE (CLASSIC IPA) (ABV 7.5% / IBU 78)

IPA (India Pale Ale) has come a long way since the sad days of the British Empire. Boundary Bay's was one of the first in the Northwest. The big malt backbone, juicy Amarillo hops and assertive bitterness make this a true classic.

Diamond Knot Brewing Co.-Mukilteo

1) SLANE'S IRISH STYLE RED (ABV 5.6%)

Sweet, caramel aroma. Malt forward, smooth & medium bodied. Toasty toffee notes. Balanced & pleasantly dry finish.

2) TROPIC ISLAND STOUT (ABV 6.0%)

Fruity aromas from a specialty yeast lay atop roasted coffee notes and Caribbean rum, smooth undertones of brown sugar are followed by a roasted barley backbone.

Elliott Bay Brewing Company-Seattle

1) Organic Mint-infused North Atlantic Haze (ABV 5.1% / IBU 35)

Our hoppy and hazy Norwegian Farmhouse Ale sings a celebration of Springtime with the addition of muddled fresh mint leaves.

2) Sour Gold (ABV 6.5%)

Inspired by the pale, sour beers of Belgium, this house sour blend at our Brother Barrel location is bright, acidic, refreshing, with a mild Brett funkyness. Look out for hints of apricots, lemon bars, oak, and white wine. Aged 10 months in oak wine barrels.

Figurehead Brewing Company-Seattle

1) PacMar Stout with bourbon, oak and vanilla (ABV 5.3%)

Our take on a dry Irish stout, cask conditioned with bourbon-soaked oak chips and whole vanilla beans.

2) Doppelbock with cherries (ABV 10.5%)

Inspired by the Austrian beer Samichlaus, this strong, rich and malty lager has been balanced with pounds of tart cherries in the cask.

3) 4-Mile Rock IPA with earl grey tea (ABV 5.5%)

Our flagship English IPA is the perfect balance of malt and English hops, complemented here by malty, floral, and citrusy notes from earl grey tea added directly to the cask.

Flying Bike Cooperative Brewery-Seattle

1) BUDDHA'S HAND Keller Kölsch (ABV 5.3%)

Classic German-style Kölsch, conditioned in the cask with shredded segments of the highly citrusy, weird-looking fruit of the asian "Buddha's Hand" plant

2) ZWICKLEBIER (ABV 4.8%)

Fresh, unfiltered Bavarian lager with Tettnanger, Hallertau Blanc, and Perle hops, conditioned in the cask

3) CHOCOLATE PORTER (ABV 6.4%)

Fremont Brewing-Seattle

1) Head Full of Dynamite v.9 with Dragonfruit (ABV 6.8%)

Our ongoing series of hazy IPAs, this version with Sabro Cryo, Ekuanot and Amarillo hops. Big guava peach notes with a low bitterness throughout. Just for Cask Fest, we through some dragonfruit to add some melon, light kiwi and bright sweetness.

2) Lush IPA with Citra and Mosaic Hops (ABV 7.0%)

This tropical treat is brewed with a hand selected blend of malts and lush, tropical hops reminiscent of lime, mango, and guava. We went and tossed some extra Citra and Mosaic hops to add a little something extra.

3) 2017 B-Bomb (ABV 13.0%)

Blend of 9/12/24 month-old barrel strength Imperial Winter Ale achieves distinct bourbon, oak, cacao, leather and dark coffee notes – aged gracefully since its release in 2017.

4) 2018 S'Mores Bourbon BA Dark Star (ABV 13.6%)

A special S'Mores Infusion of our Imperial Oatmeal Stout aged in bourbon barrels for up to two years. This beer gives off big chocolate, bourbon, dark fruit, and vanilla notes – with the delightful addition of flavors from your favorite graham cracker, marshmallow, and chocolate fire-side dessert.

Georgetown Brewing Company-Seattle

1) 9LB Porter aged in Maker's Mark Bourbon Barrels (ABV 6.6%)

Our 9# porter aged 3 months in Maker's Mark bourbon barrels with vanilla beans. Roasted chocolaty goodness with bourbon and vanilla....mmmmm boozy desert in a cup.

2) Meowsa DIPA with Grapefruit Peel (ABV 7.9%)

Medwards says "If you force fed a watermelon a steady diet of mandarin oranges and pineapples and then dropped said watermelon into a wood chipper, the resulting aromas and flavors that came out of the business end of the wood chipper would be the best way to describe this new DIPA. As much as I dislike the term 'juicy' this DIPA is very juicy and has very little bitterness for the style." Straight from the brewer's mouth.

Hale's Ales-Seattle

1) Pineapple jalapeño Supergoose

Our flagship IPA conditioned on fresh organic pineapple juice and spiced with jalapeños to add just a little kick of heat.

2) Brut 75

Our new brut-style dry IPA flavored with lemon zest and juniper berries, tastes just like a French 75!

Headless Mumby Brewing-Olympia

1) German Pils (ABV 5.9%)

With whole cone Hallertau in cask



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2) Dark Czech Lager (ABV 5.6%)

With whole cone Saaz in cask

Hellbent Brewing Company -Seattle

1) Sabro-Hopped Hazy IPA (ABV 6.5% / IBU 50)

Juicy, tropical, and citrusy IPA with Sabro Hop cask additions create a complex and fruit-forward hazy IPA.

2) Grapricot IPA (ABV 6.8% / IBU 69)

We added grapefruit and apricot to one of our IPAs to create an explosion of fruit and hops.

3) Imperial Stout with Cherries (ABV 9% / IBU 65)

Full-bodied and dark chocolate notes of this high octane stout cozy up to the sweetness of cherries added in the cask.

4) Chili-Lime Lager (ABV 5.6% / IBU 35)

Roasted habanero with lime juice and zest is added to our light and crisp lager.

1) Smack IPA (ABV 7%)

1) Ship Show IPA Cask (ABV 6.8% / IBU 50)

New England style IPA. Hazy, pale-colored IPA made with Citra and Cascade hops for strong fruity notes.

2) Bourbon Barrel Jolly Roger Cask (ABV 10% / IBU 42)

English Strong Ale. Big, malty, amber-colored sipper aged in bourbon oak for vanilla, boozy notes.

3) Irish Whisky Barrel Flagship Red (non-cask) (ABV 5.3% / IBU 28)

German Alt. Rich red alt with roasty notes cellared in Irish whisky oak for additional spice notes.

McMenamins Breweries-Bothell

1) Jackalope Barleywine (ABV 9% / IBU 54)

A caramelized hybrid of wheat and rye from the Skagit Valley lends a warm, toffee finish to this American Barleywine.

2) Long Way to the Top Double IPA (ABV 9.42% / IBU 89)

Since it's a long way to the top, why not stop for a beer? This strong, hop-forward beer has wonderful notes of tropical fruit followed by a smooth malt bill.

1) Double Nut Cheeky Monkey (ABV 11.5%)

Imperial Brown Ale infused with coconut and hazelnut.

2) Pearl's Pale Ale with Gin botanicals (ABV 5.5%)

Our Tulip Festival seasonal pale ale made with Skagit Valley Malt and infused with multiple botanicals including juniper, orange and cardamom.

1) Tasty Little Cask IPA

A tasty cask-conditioned IPA that will blow your socks off.

2) Deliciously Dark Cask Ale

1) Razzle Haze Raspberry IPA (ABV 6.4% / IBU 50)

We've infused raspberry puree into our fan favorite Tropic Haze IPA. Tropic Haze IPA utilizes a specialized yeast strain, oats, wheat, along with Strata, Citra, & Mosaic hop varieties which results in a blossom of rich, tropical fruit flavor, a silky-smooth texture, and clean finish.

2) Sun Glitter Peach IPA (ABV 6.5% / IBU 90)

Gleaning its name from the radiant visual of sunlight reflected from Pacific Ocean waves at sunset, Sun Glitter is our celebration of the Puget Sound summertime experience. A fusion of mouth-watering peach flavor with a dense, hazy malt profile, this unique IPA also incorporates lactose sugar, yielding a deliciously creamy and vanilla-like sweetness.

3) Charming Disarmer Peach Sour (ABV 5.4% / IBU 8)

She's wild. Under her enchantment you'd transcend all horizons, desperate for one more taste. Aged for two years in a barrel that once housed chardonnay; peaches, wheat, and the vanilla traits of the oak are brought together by brettanomyces, lending a subtle tartness.

4) Ripe n Juicy Double IPA (ABV 8% / IBU 75)

Like cutting into a fresh cantaloupe... if it were filled with a metric sh*t-ton of ripe, fragrant hops soaked in pineapple juice. Ripe 'N Juicy gains its signature dense, hazy body from the reaction of a specialized yeast strain with a hearty dose of flaked wheat. A massive canvas for a brilliantly fruity hop experience.

5) Fat Woody Oak Aged Scotch Ale (ABV 9.2% / IBU 25)

Fat Woody is a limited batch of our renowned Magnificent Bastard Scotch Ale aged on American white oak. The bold, smokey malt profile of the ale intertwines with the smooth, vanilla-like character of the wood for next-level incredibleness.

Stoup Brewing-Seattle

1) Zwilling IPA (zwilling means twin in german) (ABV 6.4% / IBU 57)

Born of the same mother, but separated by the Atlantic, German and American Amarillo hops are reunited in this crisp, delicious IPA. These zwillinge (twins for you non-German speaking types) bring notes of grapefruit, melon and peach, but each with their own unique American and German personalities. Enjoy this joyful reunion of hop siblings!

2) Why Stock Ale (ABV 11% / IBU 35)

A stock ale aged one year in French oak Cognac puncheons with Brettanomyces Claussenii. Brewed in collaboration with Horus Aged Ales in Oceanside, California.

3) Shapka Bourbon Barrel aged Imperial Stout (ABV 10.8% / IBU 90)



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A big, bold, roasty stout brewed with generous amounts of English crystal malt and roasted barley. Aggressively hopped yet balanced with malt sweetness and a full-bodied mouthfeel. Aged for 10 months in 12 year old Elijah Craig bourbon barrels smooths out the rough edges and contributes notes of wood, bourbon, chocolate and vanilla.

1) Fire Nemesis Imperial Milk Stout

We added some New Mexican flavor to our core imperial milk stout! The standard notes of chocolate, coffee, and cream Nemesis is known for are accented by the earthy heat of New Mexican red chili pods, the sweet heat of Ancho chili pods, and the punch from Thai chilis. The heat, while not overpowering, compliments the smoothness of the milk stout. It's Triplehorn's answer to Mexican Hot Chocolate.

A new spin on our flagship IPA. Loral and Simcoe hops combine to bring out wonderful fruit notes followed with a floral earthiness and pine. All these flavors and aromas join in a malt balanced classic IPA.

Ekuanot and Citra hops accent the light and bright nature of our hazy New England-style IPA. Ekuanot's complexity add some spice and herbal aromas while both hops add various notes of citrus to round out this easily drinkable IPA.
